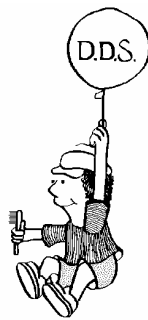


Your Child's Deimpactor

1. Avoid hard and sticky foods. A soft diet for the first few days is a good idea.
2. Do not play with the deimpactor.
3. Do not floss the space where the deimpactor was placed.
4. If the deimpactor should fall out, please call our office at your first opportunity.
5. Give your child Motrin or Advil for discomfort.
6. Both the primary molar and the permanent molar may feel loose...this is normal, as they are both moving a little. If the baby molar should fall out, please call the office.
