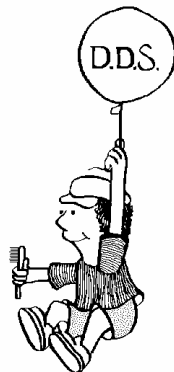


## CARE OF YOUR CHILD'S SPACE MAINTAINER

- Your child's teeth may be sore for a few days after the spacer is placed. Please give them ibuprofen (Motrin©, Advil©, etc) as needed.
- Remind your child not to play with their appliance with their tongue, fingers, pencils, etc. This could cause the appliance to loosen or break.
- FOODS TO AVOID: Ice and sticky or hard candy.
- Instruct your child to brush their teeth normally after each meal. Please help them brush and floss thoroughly before bed.
- If the appliance becomes loose or appears broken or damaged, please call us promptly. We will advise you on how to handle the situation.
- Please keep your child's regular check-ups twice a year; these appliances must be carefully monitored to ensure that they are functioning properly.
